#### Entry Fees: 10% of prize money **REGULATIONS FOR BEEF CATTLE CLASSES**

- 1. It is the responsibility of the owner and/or exhibitor to ensure that every animal under their care has the required approved tag as per CFIA regulations before entering the Listowel Fairgrounds. Any cattle that do not have the required intact/ undamaged CFIA approved tag will not be allowed entry to the fairgrounds and must leave immediately.
- 2. In the event that an animal loses their tag at the fair, then the owner or exhibitor is responsible for applying the tag and ensuring that it is done in a safe manner. Agricultural Society volunteers will not apply or assist in applying the tag. The Listowel Agricultural Society is not responsible for providing the supplies or equipment required.
- 3. Cattle must be on the fairgrounds by 10am.
- 4. Advanced registration through Assist Expo is required and can be found at: https://www.assistexpo.ca/listowel-agriculturalsociety (in person on the morning of the show will still be accepted)
- 5. Exhibitors 18 yrs. & over by virtue of paying an entry fee of 10% of their prize money are members of the society.
- 6. Livestock exhibitors must carry a minimum of one million dollars liability insurance and may be asked for proof of insurance upon registration.
- 7. All other general rules & regulations of the society apply.
- 8. Any type of abuse of animals at the show will not be tolerated and the exhibitor will be asked to leave by the Listowel Agricultural Society.
- 9. Exhibitors are responsible for removal of manure and bedding to a designated area. All garbage is to be removed from bedding.
- 10. Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Beef Cattle must be followed. Failure to follow the code of practice may result in an exhibitor being asked to leave the show.
